SERVICES AND PROGRAMS OF HCG

They can take advantage of green options, and can see their energy expenses reinvested in the local community. Hampshire Power is the community minded electricity supplier.

Net Metering Credits: Hampshire Power makes it easy for you to use sustainable sources of energy like solar, wind and biogas, no matter where you live. Through our net metering program, consumers easily receive the cost benefits of local renewable energy projects. Towns, cities, schools, businesses and non-profits can lock 15% discount on net metering credits and support local renewable energy projects.

Solar Renewable Energy Credit (SREC) Aggregation: HCG makes it easy for you to manage SRECs in a very volatile market. Our SREC team brokers the sale of over \$3 million SRECs on behalf of solar homeowners, towns, schools, businesses and non-profits in Massachusetts. - **Fuels:** Diesel, Gasoline, #2 Heating Fuel Oil
- **Medical Supplies:** Cooperative Bid with the Central Massachusetts Planning Agency for Emergency Medical Supplies

Hampshire Web:

The Hampshire Web program is designed to help smaller towns get better websites at affordable prices. Town websites have gone from

luxury to necessity, and by utilizing the Hampshire Web program, towns can present a sophisticated, functional website. Towns can better serve their residents and the general public online, with features such as town news, online payment, events calendar, town meeting minutes, emergency notification, citizen forums...and more!
